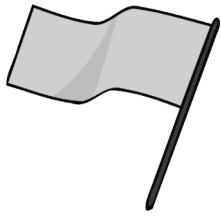
HINDLEY HERITAGE CELEBRATION NIGHT

Don't miss this incredible, free opportunity to introduce your children to different cultures and help them know their peers on a deeper level!

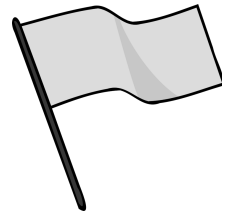


DIFFERENT WAYS TO GET INVOLVED:

HINDLEY FAMILY FLAGS



As part of this year's Hindley's Heritage celebration, we invite you to create a flag that represents your family.

This is a great activity to complete individually or as a family.

It can be any shape or size you would like.



Here are some prompts to get you started:

- What does it mean to be part of *your* family
- Do you have a family motto
- Consider how you can represent your family's hobbies and/or traditions
- What are your family values
- Is there a place, food, or holiday that is special to your family
- Consider the different people in your family and how they could be represented on your flag



The United States flag is red, white, and blue for a reason! Each color was chosen to represent a value.

What values best represent your family?

COLOR KEY

Blue = justice, wisdom, trust
 Green = hope, nature, growth
 Purple = nobility, creativity, ambition
 Black = power, grief, sorrow
 Orange = strength, energy, enthusiasm
 Red = courage, valor, love
 Silver or white = faith, purity
 Yellow or gold = honor, loyalty, joy



Family crests were used in Europe throughout the 11-17 centuries as reminders of family past, present and future. Images and animals were used to represent family values and allegiances.

Here are some commonly used symbols or create your own.

Anchor = hope	Key = service in church
Axe = military service and duty	Lion = strength, valor
Bear = protection	Oak tree or leaf = reliability
Bee = industry, self-made	Otter = intelligence
Book = listen, learning	Peacock = power
Butterfly = peace	Ram = strength
Castle = safety	Rainbow = prosperity
Cloud = faith and consistency	Snake = medicine, health
Dragon = courage	Squirrel = perseverance
Falcon = person of action	Sun = glory
Goat = persistence	Sword = honor in battle
Grapes = industry, plenty	Tower = protection
Hound dog = leadership	Unicorn = courage
